KEEP IT SIMPLE

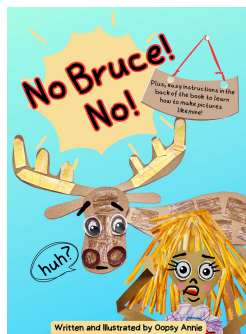
Limit the interference of too many resources with additional costs & fees. In the selection of resources you decide to use, DO invest in quality and convenience of ease. Here are mine.

Canva has options that are FREE to use. HOWEVER, I recommend you pay their yearly fee. It's worth it. You then can use Canva's A4 format to create your book – all of it! Front, cover, back cover, add images like photos & drawings, use their copy write free images. Add your document, poems...etc. Then, all you do is save it as a pdf, export it into your computer, and download directly from there into the publishing site.
